



MIRMONT - "MOUNTAIN OF PEACE"



MIRMONT Alcoholism Treatment Center had their grand opening on October 20th, 1985. The speaker was the Honorable Pierre S. duPont IV.

The Center is designed to offer in-depth comprehensive treatment to men and women from age 14, and to families and significant others. Central to this effort, is the belief that alcoholism is an illness with physical, psychological and social components, and that each must be addressed in the course of treatment.

MIRMONT is a 90-bed facility on 32 acres of land. The location is, 100 Yearsley Mill Road, Lima, PA. Within this single story lodge-style structure, residential treatment is provided for individuals and families who are struggling with this disease of alcoholism and with its impact upon their lives.

MIRMONT provides treatment through three program components:

1. The Adolescent Program - with a discrete unit of 30 beds and a minimum 28 day length of stay.

2. The Family Program - designed to meet special needs of family members and significant others through a 5 day residential program.

3. The Adult Program - with a minimum stay of 28 days, designed to meet the special needs of this population.

Each of these components, in addition to residential services, emphasizes after care planning which will include back to work/school conferences.

The philosophy of Alcoholics Anonymous permeates all phases of treatment and is an integral part of the approach to care of the alcoholic and his/her family.

MIRMONT'S multi-disciplinary staff consists of Physicians, PHD Psychologists, Certified Addiction Counselors, Family Therapists, Social Workers, and Registered Nurses. Also offered, are spiritual, nutritional and physical fitness counseling.

MIRMONT'S ADMISSION CRITERIA

- \*Chemical-free for 5 days prior to admission.
- \*14 years of age for adolescent program.
- \*18 years of age for adult program.
- \*Must be able to take care of his/her physical needs.
- \*Does not manifest a medical and/or a psychiatric problem that would preclude participation in the program.
- \*Able to make a verbal commitment to treatment in a 28 day program.

Jack (J.W.) Laufer disarmed the woman, snatching the rifle with his right hand and grabbing the suspect with his left hand. J. W.'s heroic action is credited for saving lives and additional injuries to many more whom were exposed to danger.

J. W. is the son of Mr. and Mrs. John Laufer. His mother is Marion Laufer, Director of Nurses at RMH. J. W. is a graduate student at Widener University, working toward his MBA in Hospital Administration. Besides Health Care, J. W. is interested in police work.

J. W. is always busy at Country Fair time at Riddle Memorial Hospital. When the snow
